Question	Answer
How many spaces are available for international students at Southampton on the BM5 Medicine programme?	At the moment we have 18 spaces available.
Do you accept A level retakes?	Applicants who are retaking their A Levels/GCSES/or equivalent qualifications will be considered for our programmes. However, if applicants have retaken the same subjects more than once, these applications will be considered on a case by case basis. If a subject is not retaken the following year but at a later date, these applications will be considered on a case by case basis. If accepted, the offer would be the same as the standard offer for the appropriate programme. We are unable to consider applications from applicants who fail to meet the requirements of their offer then shortly afterwards undertake a different, equivalent qualification. For example, we will not consider an application from an A Level student who undertakes an Access course shortly after completing their A Level.
What sort of UCAT score was sufficient for international students to reach interview stage this year?	The lowest UCAT score amongst those international students who were invited to interview this year was 2520. (As compared to the lowest for home students, which was 2570).
Do Southampton look at the situational judgement part of the UCAT test?	We don't look at the situational judgement.
